125ml/175ml/250ml Bottle

2021 Luberon Rose, Famille Perrin, Southern Rhone, France 4.90/6.80/9.70 29.00
If you like an easy drinking rose wine, this one is a winner for you. Very refreshing with raspberry and pink grapefruit flavours, delicate in colour with aromas of wild strawberry and nectarine.

2022 Tendem Rosé, Languedoc, France 30.00
On the palate, taste of strawberry yoghurt and a candy-floss finish, with a fresh acidity for a lingering delicious mouth-feel. Rachel's go-to Rosé for a good reason!

2021 'Cuvee Alexandre', Chateau Beaulieu, France 7.60/10.55/15.10 45.00
This rose is brilliantly clear with pale peach accents. The nose displays delicate aromas of white flowers, citrus and juicy white peach and pear notes. Fresh, fruity and slightly dry... get me a bottle in garden asap!

2020 Blanc de Blancs, Raventos I Blanc, Catalunya, Spain 9.20 55.00
Fresh notes of citrus with a beautifully balanced finish. You'll be feeling like your sitting on a terrace in Barcelona in no time.

2018 Classic Cuvee Brut, Rathfinny wine estate, Southern England 12.50 75.00
Aromas of grapefruit, red apple and brioche on the nose. The palate has real focus with zesty acidity and creamy texture. A very refreshing sparkling pleasure!

2018 Rose Brut, Rathfinny wine estate, Southern England 85.00
Rathfinny's rosé has a pale coral hue and a vibrant nose with aromas of cranberry, cherry blossom and red apple. The palate is lively with concentrated notes of pink grapefruit and brioche. Life is too short to drink bad wine, so please go for it

NV Brut Reserve, Charles Heidsieck, Champagne, France 130.00

Château Kalian Bernasse, Monbazillac, Bordeaux, France 8.50 51.00
This wine is powerful, underscored with a refreshing acidity stunning fruity taste that comes from quality grapes. Beautifully fresh and elegant, a perfect way to end of the evening!

Domaine Fontanel 'Tautavel' Maury Grenat 9.00 54.00
Domaine Fontanel Maury is a lightly fortified Vin Doux Naturel made from Grenache Noir. Chocolate and spice, the rest is a secret. Again, you'll rush to grab a picture of the label for this one!

Lions de Suduiraut, Sauternes, Bordeaux, France 60.00
This wine has been specifically designed to reveal the pleasures of taste provided by Sauternes wines. This wine is more velvety, fresh and complex than other wines in its class.

WHITE WINE

2022 Macabeo, Familia Castaño, Yecia, Murcia, Spain 4.60/6.25/9.10 27.00
A light golden wine that shows layered aromas of ripe stone fruit such as apricot and peach, with mouth-watering acidity. Organic, bio-dynamic and dangerously good!

2021, Paarl heights, Chenin Blanc, Paasrl, South Africa 4.90/6.80/9.70 29.00
A classic Chenin from sunny South Africa with ripe fruit, mouth watering acidity and an elegant finish. Great value wine perfect for seafood dishes, or just on its own!

2022, Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Corte Giara, Veneto, Italy 5.40/7.50/10.70 32.00
Intense notes of citrus and red stone, slightly floral and dry as a good pinot should be, and this is a good pinot. A true classic that cannot be missed.

2022 Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France 5.40/7.50/10.70 32.00
Fresh, fruit and a real fan favorite over the years here at the bridge, it would cause mayhem taking this stunning wine off our menu. Alvaro calls this 'dangerously drinkable' because one glass isn't enough. Sweet aromas of peach and red apple make this one a winner in our book.

2021 Vinho Verde, Alvarinho Reserva, Azevedo, Portugal 5.70/7.95/11.40 34.00
Full of intense aromatics like nectarine, apricot and mango and equally intense in the flavors but well balanced in acidity. It's the ideal wine to finish a long day and you need that something to stand up to what you went through

2022 Viogner, Bodega Garzon estate, Maldonado, Uruguay 36.00
We know what your thinking, we thought it to, a top wine from Uruguay? Well this is indeed that. A blended wine with honeysuckle aromas and white peach on the palate this is one for those looking for that extra bit of acidity from their wines.

2022 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Tinpot Hut, New Zealand 6.60/9.15/13.10 39.00
Fiona and Hamish welcomed Graham and Rachel to the vineyard and after several (and the rest) tastings of their wines this one made it straight from NZ to our menu and hasn't moved since. A pure and classic sauvignon perfect for any meal!

2021 Macon Matisco, Chardonnay, Burgundy, France 7.60/10.55/15.10 45.00
Having been farmed since the early 90s this wine is more Oasis than Ace of base... after tasting this people still talk about it and who remembers Ace of base? The notes of lemon and jasmine make this chardonnay excellent value and drinks effortlessly... much like an oasis member or 2.

2021 'Purist' Mosel Riesling Kabinett Trocken, Axel Pauly, Germany 46.00
Fresh and medium bodied with a striking mineral character that became a bit of a favorite at our tasting. Tropical fruit notes that become quiet clear on the first taste with a beautiful long finish this is one of those wines that can even go well from the first to the last course

2021 'Montessoro' Gavi di Gavi, La Giustiniana, Piemonte, Italy 8.70/12.15/17.50 52.00
Gavi has become one of the most popular varieties of white in the world over the recent years and it's not hard to see why. The montessoro is a brilliant example of a Gavi that is full of flavour with hints of peach and lime and pairs perfectly with our Lothian chicken

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WHITE WINE CONT. 125ml/175ml/250ml Bottle

2021 Sancerre, Domaine des brosses, Loire, France 9.20/10.30/18.40 55.00
This wine displays aromas of ripe citrus and white flowers, paired with herbaceous notes, it really highlights the beauty that is come from the freshness of a sancerre. This one was a winner for our Restaurant manager Alvaro. It will stand up to all the bold flavours on our menu.

2021 'Louro Do Bolo', Valdeorras Godello, Galicia, Spain 60.00
This is a mature wine but with great freshness and acidity. Very full bodied with the most tasty of fruit notes, a perfect accompaniment to our gnocchi to cut through those fresh tomato flavours and not get lost

2022 Marlborough Chardonnay, Greywacke, New Zealand 74.00
The aromas of toasted hazelnut and hot buttered brioche (yes you read that right). This elaborate fusion of sweet-scented aromatics and a smoky, nutty savouriness carries through onto a wonderfully dry example of a chardonnay. This one is perfect with a number of our dishes especially our Salt Hake with the light spices pairing perfectly.

2020 'La Rocca' Soave Classico, Pieropan, Veneto, Italy 88.00
100% Garganega grape, this wine has the richness and zest that makes it such an attractive wine. It is scented and beautifully defined with hints of honeysuckle and almond on the finish. A totally different experience that you won't regret

2020 Chablis 'Les Fourneaux', Domaine Corinne Perchaud, Burgundy, France 84.00
Having been farmed since the early 90s this wine is more Oasis than Ace of base... after tasting this people still talk about it and who remembers Ace of base? The notes of lemon and jasmine make this chardonnay excellent value and drinks effortlessly... much like an oasis member or 2.

2020 Bourgogne Blanc, 'Le clos du Chateau de Puligny-Montrachet', Burgundy, France 98.00
This wine boasts exuberantly fresh aromas of lemon rind and white orchard fruit, with generous mouthfeel thanks to the clay soils. The palate is fresh and expressive, displaying ripe stone fruit flavours balanced with bright acidity and a persistent finish

2020 Saint-Romain, David Moret, Burgundy, France 105.00
A pale golden colour, with youthful reflections of glass. On the nose there is buttery characteristics with notes of lemon. On the palate there is balanced acidity and a mineral touch round off the citrus flavours before a lingering finish

2017 'Kaferberg' Erste Lage Kamptal Gruner Veltliner, Loimer, Austria 115.00
The 2017 'Kaferberg' has an intense bouquet of tallow apple, dried banana, oranges and spicy pepper that hits you from the start. Lively acidity with citrus fruit characters and full of body that will stay with you throughout the bottle and then some.

2017 Santa Rita Hills Chardonnay, Raciness, California, USA 140.00
The winery brought together 2 renowned families and brought all the best aspects of Champagne, California and Burgundy to the Santa Rita Hills. Lemon confit, white flours and white pepper this is a stunning layered wine for the medium-bodied fan.

RED WINE 125ml/175ml/250ml Bottle

2021 Evaristo Tinto, Lisboa, Portugal 4.60/6.25/9.10 27.00
Bright Red fruits with light savoury notes of nutmeg and chocolate characters. Sweet ripe plum and berry fruits with a subtle vanilla and oak character. Its our house red for a reason, Portuguese sunshine in a glass!

2021 Colchagua Merlot, Montes, Chile 5.10/7.05/10.10 30.00
A great addition to our cellar. This wine contains a medium body with red fruits, sweet spices and hints of fresh tobacco. The tannins linger on the finish and this fantastic wine is perfect for any of our steaks!

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Kaiken Clasico, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 5.40/7.50/10.70 32.00
This wine was aged in French and American oak which offers nuances of wood spice. The wine is rich and well balanced. Moreish and dangerously good! Its been a fan favorite over the years here at the bridge and has to remain a staple on our menu!

2020 El Coto, Rioja, Spain 5.55/7.75/11.05 33.00
This Tempranillo has the hallmarks of a great red Rioja with a ton of fruit, subtle oak notes and mouth racing acidity it begs for a dish with big bold flavours and a perfect match for one of Gus's dishes!

2020 Cotes-du-Rhone, Famille Perrin, Southern Rhone, France 6.35/8.90/12.70 38.00
This is our absolute go to for anyone that is struggling to make that decision. We wanted to find a wine that competed with our old Montepulciano and this has certainly done that. A truly excellent wine with notes of strawberries and redcurrant. This medium bodied wine should be your go to from now on and it pairs wonderfully with our borders lamb!

2019 'Vinha Grande' Douro Tinto, Casa Ferreirinha, Portugal 6.70/9.35/13.40 40.00
A wine Alvaro enjoyed so much he bought a case from our supplier during the tasting! Notes of plum, blackberries and a slightly smoky finish that only adds to the balance. He is sure you will find this one of your new favorites as well

2021 Fleurie, Dominique Morel, Beaujolais, France 7.60/10.55/15.10 45.00
Elegant red fruit aromas, well balanced and long length. The perfect match for this is a day off the next day... one bottle isn't enough for this one.

2019 Barossa Valley Shiraz, The Barossan, South Australia 8.10/11.25/16.10 48.00
The contents matches this striking bottle. Made by one of the finest producers of wine anywhere in the world Peter Lehmann, this wine is extremely fragrant with aromas of plum and red berries with notes of vanilla and coconut from the American oak.

2021 Rua, Pinot Noir, Akarua, New Zealand 9.20/12.85/18.40 55.00
Bright cherry red in the glass. Lifted cherry aromas with floral and violet notes. On the palate, this well-defined Pinot Noir exhibits juicy red fruits. Put this up against any red Burgundy and this wine will knock it out the park!

2021 Langhe Nebbiolo, Corino Giovanni do Corino Giuliano, Piemonte, Italy 58.00
A very fragranced and unoaked wine, with predominant notes of cherry and juicy red fruit. Very delicate and tasty and perfect for those red drinkers on a warm summer day or that cozy spot by the fire.

2021 Crozes-Hermitage Rouge, maison les Alexandrins, Northern Rhone, France 63.00
Aromas of ripe red and black fruit with seductive pepper and smoky hints. Very fresh on the palate... can you really say no to a seductive red wine?

2019 'Petignano' Chianti Classico, Dievole, Tuscany, Italy 70.00
We have finally got a Chianti that we really liked on our menu! Full bodied and juicy, ruby red in colour with concentrated ripe black fruit flavours and fine tannins. Honestly Alvaro was so happy we have this wine in our cellar!

2019 Chateaufort-du-pape 'Grand Vin', Chateau de Vaudieu, Southern Rhone, France 95.00
The winery name comes from the name Valley of God, so mix that with a chateaufort-du-pape and you have the makings of a truly once in a lifetime wine. A lively acidity with a good concentration of supple tannins evolving throughout the tasting, this was one bottle of wine we couldn't let leave during our tasting we think you will not be disappointed either

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
